Upon completion of this physically challenging week of training, officers will be nationally certified police mountain bike officers.

Students must ride their police bicycles for most of the training with the only exception being that they can ride a personal mountain bike during off-road rides. If possible, bikes should have a rear mount kickstand.

- Water Bottles / Camelback
- Body Armor / Duty Belt
- Service Weapon (Handgun)
- 100 rounds of Practice Ammo
